- It is not to interfere with any fire control systems or sprinklers. (500mm ceiling clearance)
- It is not to interfere with any body corporate property.
- It cannot impinge outside the marked bays including the drain at the rear of the car bay.
- Any push bike will not be able to be stored in the basement if storage cabinet are installed.
- My vehicle(s) is to be parked entirely within your bay with the bonnet of the first car to be situated under the cabinet if required.
- Under no circumstances is anything to be stored outside of the storage cabinet. That includes above, beside or under the cabinet.
- Any damage done to body corporate property shall be made good by the applicant.
- No body corporate property can be drilled into without permission.
- if deemed necessary by the body corporate, the slab or walls may need to be x-rayed at the anchor points where drilling is required.
- The building manager is to be consulted immediately prior to the time of installation.
