COVERAGE

Voluntary accident insurance provides a range of fixed, lump-sum benefits for injuries resulting from a covered accident, or for accidental death and dismemberment (if included). These benefits are paid directly to the insured and may be used for any reason, from deductibles and prescriptions to transportation and childcare.

ELIGIBILITY

All eligible members.

Dependents: You must be insured in order for Dependents to be covered.

Dependents are:

- Your legal spouse or your domestic partner. Spouse must be under age 70 at date of application.
- ▶ Your dependent children* from birth to 26 years.
 - *An eligible member's child(ren) from birth to 26 years,including natural children, legally adopted children, children who are dependent on the eligible member during the waiting period before adoption, stepchildren, and foster children.

 Foster children must be in the custody of the eligible member to be considered a Dependent; and an eligible member's child(ren) beyond the limiting age who is incapable of self-sustaining employment by reason of intellectual disability or physical handicap and who is chiefly dependent on the eligible member for support and maintenance.

A person may not have coverage as both an Member and Dependent.
