Congratulations to **Carol Holland and Jesse Holland**, the inaugural RUN THE BLOCK program recipients! They will receive \$200,000 and dedicated mentorship from the RIDC network.

Native to Prince George's County, Maryland, Carol Holland is an engineer, former All-American track star, and Athletic Hall of Fame member at the U.S. Naval Academy, and her husband, Jesse Holland, is a college professor, journalist, and author. Anyone could apply to <u>RUN THE BLOCK</u> with at least 51% Black ownership, a criterion aimed at increasing access to financial support and mentorship for businesses substantially owned and run by Black individuals and addressing historical barriers to access capital.
