Please note that all entries should be at St. George's Church Hall between 5.00p.m. and 5.45p.m.

JUDGING WILL COMMENCE PROMPTLY AT 6.00pm

Prior to the Club Night meeting.

All exhibits must have been in the exhibitor's possession for a minimum of two months

CLASSES

- Class 1* 3 stems of a trumpet Daff in one vase.
- Class 2* 3 stems of a short cup or flat cup Daff in one vase.
- Class 3* 3 stems of a Double Daff - one or more flowers per stem in one vase.
- Class 4* 3 stems of a multi-flowered Daff in one vase
- Class 5* Pot (180mm (7") or less) of any cyclamineous Daff - i.e. with outer petals reflexed back
- Class 6* Pot (**100mm (4") or less**) of the given variety (TOPOLINO). **One entry only**
- Class 7* Container of 1 Hyacinth
- Class 8* Container of 3 Hyacinths of any one colour
- Class 9* Spring Flowering Bulbs or Corms of one or mixed variety- pot 180mm (7") or less diam.
- Class 10* Container of mixed Spring Flowering Plants &/or Shrubs-100cm (40") max circumference(container)
- Class 11* Vase of cut Spring Flowers &/or Flowering Shrubs from your garden 305mm (12") max width of exhibit
- Class 12* Container of 1 Amaryllis
- Class 13* Container of 5 floating Hellebore Flowers - mixed varieties permitted
- Class 14* 1 cut bloom of Camellia, with leaves, any variety
- Class 15* 3 Leeks (trimmed)
- Class 16* 3 Parsnips (trimmed)
- Class 17* Any other seasonal Vegetable (including rhubarb)

Trophies will be awarded for: Daffodil Section; Cut Flowers; Flower Section; Hyacinth Section; Amaryllis Section; Most points in Show; Best in Show; President's Choice.
