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1. Executive Research Profile

Jermaine E. Whiteside is a doctoral researcher in Christian Leadership at Liberty University whose applied scholarship integrates governance science, artificial intelligence governance, institutional trust, constitutional and public-policy analysis, Christian leadership, and organizational systems design. He founded the Governance Science Research Program as an independent research initiative focused on developing governance frameworks, measurement models, evidence architectures, and implementation systems for educational institutions, nonprofit organizations, businesses, governments, and faith communities.

His current scholarship includes the Faithful Intelligence research program; governance latency and institutional-trust research; evidence-governance standards and verification architectures; public-policy and constitutional-governance studies; and operational research translating governance principles into auditable institutional practice. His work is disseminated through SSRN (22 publicly distributed working papers; 681 recorded downloads as of August 10, 2026) and conference presentation, including the Religious Education Association, and he completed peer-review service for the 2027 American Educational Research Association Annual Meeting.

2. Research Philosophy

This research program builds governance systems that hold up under audit: constitutional accountability paired with empirical measurement, and ethical claims about artificial intelligence tied to verifiable evidence. Its working rule is that evidence precedes advocacy, and that any framework offered to an institution must be reproducible by someone outside it.
