Instructions on how to remotely access the meeting.

We will be using the Zoom videoconferencing service to provide remote hosting for our meeting. If you use a computer, tablet, or smartphone to access the meeting, you will have access to both the audio and video feed. If you use a basic cell phone or landline to access the meeting, you will only have access to the audio feed. In either case, you will be able to ask questions or make comments during the meeting.

If you use a computer, you will need to download and install the free Zoom Client for Meetings app from the Zoom website (<https://zoom.us/download>) before the meeting. If you use a tablet or smartphone, you can download the app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store. (It may take several minutes to complete this process so you should do it well beforehand.)

If you are using a computer, tablet, or smartphone for audio and video access using the Zoom app:

1. Click on the following link:

Open the Zoom app on your device and click on the Join a Meeting button and, if asked, enter the meeting number 656 605 1004 and password AAUW2020.

2. Please note that when you join the meeting using the audio/video option, it may take several seconds after the video connects for the audio to connect.

If you are using a basic cell phone or landline for audio access only:

1. Dial either 312 626-6799 or 301 715-8592 and enter the meeting number followed by the pound sign 6566051004# and the password followed by the pound sign 414137#.
2. If neither number works, try one of the following numbers and enter the meeting number and password followed by the pound sign when prompted: 646 558-8656, 253 215-8782, or 346 248-7799.
