- a. Road Commissioner:

  - Loose cobbles on Monunet
  - MSK will come to January meeting to talk about Fairview & Bank
  - Salt: 250 tons @ \$86/ton ordered for the year
- b. Tree Commissioner
  - none
- c. Parks and Sidewalks Commissioner:
  - Ann Jensen Bench organized for the spring
  - Corresponding re: marble sidewalks damage
- d. Police Commissioner:
  - 0 hours, 0 property watches, 0 traffic tickets, \$0 in potential fines. (no officer)
  - After many meetings/negotiations, agreement between BPD and commissioner on \$52/hour for police coverage 10-15 hrs/week (traffic, parking, patrol, property checks) through Bennington police department officers on 'special assignment' rather than a dedicated Old Bennington officer.
  - EW moves to authorize the Police Commissioner to execute an agreement with the Town of Bennington for up to 20 hours a week of coverage at \$52/hour. SA seconds. Motion passes unanimously.
