- 1. Opening. The meeting was called to order at 7:00.
- 2. Minutes. There were no changes to the posted minutes. Steven Anisman moved to approve the minutes from the August meeting. Susan Wright seconded. The Trustees unanimously approved the motion.
- 3. Commissioner Reports
  - A. Police
    - i. Vehicle
      - time to think about replacing 2009 cruiser
      - some work recently done at no cost & low cost, but nearing end of usefulness
      - Sheriff dept could buy old car; long order lead time for new car
      - v6 all-wheel drive with police wiring package is officer recommendation
      - ~ \$45,000 in total
      - \$47,590 in total for car and equipment available in budget
      - Steven moves to authorize up to \$47,590 for cruiser, Ed seconds. Motion passes unanimously.
    - ii. Body cameras
      - Bennington policy: 'officers shall be equipped with body cameras'. Officer Andy should have one to be in compliance.
      - It makes sense to try to get on board with Bennington's download/storage system.
      - \$600-\$800 for camera equipment
      - Steven Anismen moves to purchase body cam equipment, seconded by Ed Woods. Motion passes
    - iii. Officer Andv
