BEFORE SCHOOL CARE ROUTINE (BSC)

Hours - 6:30am - 8:45am

Q. Can my child have breakfast and brush their
teeth at Kids Club?

A. YES OF COURSE!!

Breakfast is for anybody within our serving times.
Hot breakfast is served from 6:30am – 7:20 am.

Cold breakfast finishes at 7:50 am.

Dietary requirements are catered for.

Permanent bookings, we will provide a toothbrush & toothpaste for your child.

Casual bookings, children may bring their own toothbrush with them.

Children are walked up to school with an educator at bell time, until they are confident to walk up with older children at 8.30am.

Activities are set up in the hall on a daily basis. If you have any particular activity your child enjoys please let us know.

Child to educator ratios are in place daily, so please give us as much notice as possible, if you require a casual booking request your booking through the app or message Tania on 0417416678.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE ROUTINE (ASC)

Hours - 3:00pm -6:00pm

Educators will collect all the Kindergarten children from their classrooms and bring them to our meeting point, with years 1-6 on the playground for roll call. Once all children are accounted for we move to the hall to wash our hands and get ready for afternoon tea.

Afternoon tea is provided daily with multiple options & our menu is rotated weekly.
