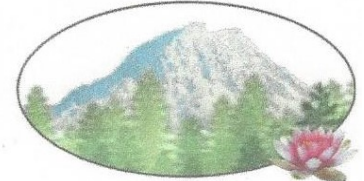

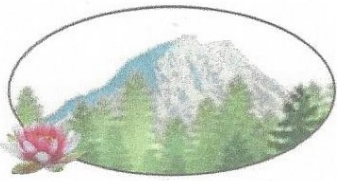

Spring weather in Washington can be unpredictable but we hope that the weather Gods will look favorably on us, and we will all enjoy beautiful spring weather.

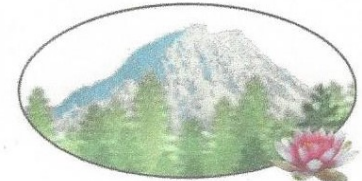
