HOTEL AND TRANSPORTATION

The Little America Hotel is a 4-Diamond hotel and has been a local favorite for over 60 years! Nestled between the Wasatch and Oquirrh Mountain Ranges in the magnificent Salt Lake Valley is a 10-acre paradise with fountains, 70-year old trees, and colorful flower gardens. Little America's Garden Rooms are located within these beautifully landscaped grounds in three separate two-story buildings. Each room includes a comfortable sitting area with a second basin and vanity outside of a large bathroom. Views from the extra-wide sliding glass doors make the rooms feel even more spacious. A desk or table and small refrigerator add to the convenience and luxury.

Little America is within walking distance from shopping, restaurants, cultural and sporting events. Other nearby attractions include historic Temple Square, the world-famous Great Salt Lake and national parks, forests, and monuments. When booking with the hotel directly, make sure you give them the block code to get our group discount!!

Discounted Room Rate: \$149 plus tax per night for double occupancy. \$20 per person per night for each additional person, up to 4 people per room – no rollaway. This price is for Garden Rooms. You may upgrade to a Tower Room, based on availability, for \$209 per night double occupancy. Same additional person rate applies. The hotel will honor our room rate for 3 days prior to and 3 days after the event.

Check-In Time: 3:00pm Check-Out Time: 11:00am

There is a 50% discounted parking rate. At the time of this packet, the overnight self-parking rate is \$15/night and the overnight valet parking rate is \$20/night, making our cost \$7.50 or \$10 per night. Price may be different in September.

All guestrooms are non-smoking in accordance with Utah's Clean Air Act.

PLEASE NOTE: There are three buildings with "Courtside Rooms." Courtside Room buildings are two-story buildings that <u>do not</u> have elevators. All buildings with "Garden Rooms" have elevators. If you cannot navigate stairs, please request a ground-floor room or a "Garden Room."

Room Service is available from 6:00am to 12 midnight daily.

Salt Lake's International Airport is only 7 miles (roughly 10 minutes) away with an average Taxi/Uber/Lyft fare of \$20, not including gratuity.

PRIVATE TOURS & ACTIVITIES

For the following tours you will be on your own to make reservations that fit your schedule, pay for the tours and arrange for hotel pickup or other transport to and from the hotel.

Hop-On-Hop-Off Bus Tour of SLC – Adult Day passes are \$35 for one day and \$41 for 2 days. Senior cost is \$33/day and \$35/2 day. Stops include 29 attractions like Capitol Hill, Hogle Zoo, the Salt Lake LDS Temple, Family History Library/Temple Square, Cathedral of the Madeleine, Lion house, and others.
