## 2023 PROTECTORS AWARDS (Formerly SOAR & LEO Awards)

The ASIS Greater Orlando Chapter will be holding the 23rd annual Protectors Awards ceremony on May 25, 2023. We are excited to restart this ceremony after the devastating COVID-19 pandemic.

By way of background, this event has proven itself to be the best and largest law enforcement recognition and awards program in the southeast United States. The event has recognized over 260 of the "best of the best" among Central Florida law enforcement during the last 22 years. We annually draw between 300 and 600 attendees, including the sheriffs of four counties, chiefs from area departments, directors of security, hotel and resort management and other business leaders. 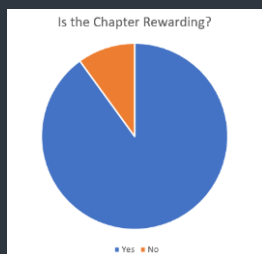
