2023 PROTECTORS AWARDS (Formerly SOAR & LEO Awards)

The ASIS Greater Orlando Chapter will be holding the 23rd annual Protectors Awards ceremony on May 25, 2023. We are excited to restart this ceremony after the devastating COVID-19 pandemic.


