John Nilsen a native of Seattle, Washington, began studying classical piano from his mother at age six. Continuing his musical education, he began playing guitar at age fourteen. He attended Southern Oregon University and was honored by the institution in 1995 in recognition of his outstanding achievements, dedicated efforts and leadership in the field of the performing arts with the Distinguished Alumnus Award, the most prestigious award bestowed upon SOU graduates.



An accomplished pianist,

guitarist, composer, lyricist and vocalist, Nilsen has performed in all 50 states as well as Europe and Asia. Like each of the past thirty years, John played 240 performances until Covid-19 hit in 2020. Nilsen splits his performances between touring internationally as an in-demand pianist combining elements of classical, folk, and jazz, performing with the John Nilsen Trio. He has also been a member of TenGrands (ten grand pianos, ten amazing pianists, on one stage in Portland, Oregon) since its inception in 2001, and has given back to his community by teaching songwriting residencies and speaking to students in schools throughout the country and in his local school district over the past twenty-five years. He was just recently inducted into the Oregon Music Hall of Fame in October of 2024.
