Burning Regulations

**** To be safe and to be sure that you are doing your burning correctly, please follow all of the following regulations:**

- 1. Burn days are limited to Saturday, Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday from 7:00 A.M. until Sundown. Permission to burn at these days and times are subject to change depending on local weather conditions.**
- 2. Do not allow persons less than 18 years of age or persons in an impaired State of Mind to light or be in control of your fire. Insure a responsible Adult is present at all times.**
- 3. If you are planning a bonfire at night call and inform the Fire Department. Also inform your neighbors of what you intend to do. Make sure that you choose a good location so that the smoke does not go into nearby residences or their outside air intakes.**
- 4. Give us the location of the proposed burn and the time you expect to start burning.**
- 5. Burn piles must be limited to 4'x4'x8', or about the size of a pick-up truck bed.**
- 6. Place burn piles at least 50' from all buildings, vehicles, trees, power lines, and any other combustible items.**
- 7. The person obtaining the permit must attend the fire at all times and until all danger of a rekindle is over.**
- 8. You must have a charged water hose, a rake, shovel or hoe available at the burn site at all times while burning. You must be able to control the fire at all times.**
- 9. Only cut brush, paper and wood products may be burned.**
- 10. Soak the burn area after the fire is out. Make sure the fire is completely out and no "hot spots" are left.**
- 11. The burn permit is only good for the date and time stated on the permit. If you cannot start your burn within 30 minutes of the stated burn time please contact the fire department.**
- 12. Waste matter shall not be burned under permit or otherwise which will cause or create a dense smoke or odor.**

These rules are for your safety as well as for the health and safety of others.
