"I will give you thanks, for you answered me; you have become my salvation." Psalm 118:21

Thanksgiving and praise to God is the proper response of God's people for answered prayer. Surely, God has answered our cry many times. Perhaps he has provided for your need for work; maybe he has strengthened and healed you in sickness; maybe he has protected you in the face of evil and danger; or maybe he has granted you that firm assurance in the midst of doubt. In fact, in verses 23 and 24 of this passage he says, "...the LORD has done this, and it is marvellous in our eyes. The LORD has done it this very day; let us rejoice today and be glad." Dear friends, do not wait to offer your thanksgiving to God tomorrow. Salvation is yours today and today is the day to give thanks!
