Selection criteria for Horse of the Year

The Horse of the Year (HOTY) award recognises a Queensland horse and rider combination that has met the criteria and had exceptional performances throughout the calendar year in each Competitive Level of Working Equitation.



To be eligible for the ANWE Qld HOTY Competition, a rider/horse combination must:

1. Be a current, financial, and competitive level (Preliminary and above) member of ANWEL and a Qld ANWEL affiliated Working Equitation Club.
2. Compete in and successfully complete the dressage, ease of handling (EOH) and speed phases at a minimum of four (4) Qld HOTY Competitions throughout the competition year, including the Qld State Championships.

Please note:

- Elimination in the dressage, ease of handling (EOH) and/or speed phase at a HOTY competition will mean that the results from that competition will not be counted towards the overall HOTY result.
- Horse and rider combinations will be eligible to be awarded HOTY in one level only.

The HOTY Champion for each competitive level (Preliminary – Masters) will be determined by:

- The top three (3) results by an individual rider/horse combination who have met the criteria are calculated to identify the HOTY in each competitive.

Presentation will be at the final Qld HOTY Competition.
