Selection criteria for the **Bexley Award**

The Bexley Award is for the fastest official time for an individual to pen a beast in the cattle phase during the competition season including the Queensland State Championships.



To be eligible for the ANWE Qld Bexley Award, a rider/horse combination must:

- 1. Be a current, and financial, member of ANWEL and a Qld ANWEL affiliated Working Equitation Club.
- 2. Compete in a minimum of two (2), official three (3) or four (4) phase Qld HOTY Competitions throughout the competition year.
- 3. Successfully complete the cattle phase in accordance with the ANWEL Official Rulebook © 2024 at a Qld HOTY Competition within the competition year.

Please note:

- Team placings will not be considered.
- All individual horse/rider combinations from Preparatory (L2) upwards are eligible.

The Bexley Award Champion will be determined by:

 The fastest official time for an individual to pen a beast in the cattle phase at any HOTY Competition throughout the competition season within a single year.

Presentation will be at the final Qld HOTY Competition of the year.
