**A Pet Peeve.** How would you like to be at a club game and, in your turn to bid, ask your opponent what their bid means, only to hear *nothing*? The player has NO convention card and totally ignores you. It is very frustrating. Well, that's what it's like in our games on BBO when pairs don't have a convention card to view, they don't have anything in

their profile, they don't know how to Alert their bids and they don't know how to respond when asked.

Firstly, I give lots of kudos to most of our players that DO have a convention card for them and the partner they are playing with at the moment, they DO have a little info in their BBO profile telling what conventions they use and they DO alert their bids.

For the others, I'll tell you how to learn how to do it. Let's pretend you are on the "Who Wants to Be a Millionaire" TV game show: You are asked a question. You have the following options:

- Ask a friend. Call a friend, or your partner, and ask them how you do these things on BBO.
- Look it up. See my writeups in my past Weekly Blasts that are posted on our website here <u>Bridge Buzz | VUBC (vcbridge.org)</u>. Specifically, the 9/7/20 edition (convention cards); the 8/17/20 edition (alerts); the 7/27/20 edition (BBO profile)
- Watch a video. BBO has help videos on this site <u>BBO video tutorial playlist -</u> (bridgebase.com) OR GOOGLE "you tube videos" and you'll see bunches of helpful videos.
- Here's a hint. Click on the "Account" tab on the right side of BBO's screen and just look around. Play with it. Click on your bid when you are bidding. Watch what happens. To get rid of the "Alert" box, click it again.
