

A message from Tad Van Leer, ALA President

I would like to start this note by wishing all of the Alamoosook extended community a happy, healthy, and prosperous new year. I hope that 2024 will bring us together to enjoy the lake and fellowship. I would also like to note that the board had a resignation- Lynn Ames whom we will miss and thank her for all her work. In her place, the board has nominated Gina Bushong, for your final approval. In my mind, Gina has done more to help move this program along and is a great addition.

During our membership meeting in August, we discussed the potential ownership changes with the Alamoosook and Toddy Pond Dams. The purpose of this email is to update you on the most recent news. Just over a week ago, AIM's representative contacted the Toddy Pond Association (TPA) and stated that AIM was now interested in finding new ownership for the dams. They were interested in assessing the lake associations interest in the properties.

The Board has already been developing long-term options for the ownership/management of the dams, however, given this news, we are now focused on identifying options for the near term to maintain our pristine lakes. To date, the board has undertaken the following actions:

- 1. Establishing a Coalition of the local towns, lake associations, trusts, and other stakeholders to prepare for the future. The ALA is now actively working with TPA and the Town of Orland as well as others to find solution. We have made it clear that ALA would not be future dam owners.
- 2. Working with our partners, we are exploring multiple options for future ownership that will lead to not only the preservation of the dams but significant improvement to the fishways and the broader environment. We are in the beginning stages and as more information is gained, we will keep you well-informed and provide lots of opportunities for broader membership input and involvement. Stay tuned for more shortly.

We are pleased to announce that Ellie Castilla has volunteered to head up the CBI (Courtesy Boat Inspections)
Program this summer. As you are aware, this is of vital importance to keep our lake pristine. THE CBI PROGRAM NEEDS

ON NOVEMBER 3RD, THE MORINING STARTED AS A PINK SIGHT TO SEE. WINTER AT THE LAKE IS AMAZING.

QUICKLY, THE DAY TURNED TO TRAGEDY AND THE PINK SUNRISE FADED FROM OUR MEMORY. OUR DEAR NEIGHBORS AND FRIENDS, APRIL AND JOE, LOST THEIR FAMILY HOME IN ORLAND MAINE TO AN EXPLOSION AND FOLLOWING FIRE. JUST A LITTLE AFTER 9AM, THE HOUSE EXPLODED RESULTING IN BOTH THE HOMEOWNERS AND THEIR GUEST BEING INJURED. AFTER EVERYONE WAS EVACUATED, A FIRE THEN IGNITED FROM THE EXPLOSION SITE. THIS LEVELED WHAT WAS LEFT OF THE HOUSE, AND BADLY DAMAGED AND BURNED THE APARTMENT WHERE MIKE AND KYLIE RESIDE. THE PARTS OF THE HOUSE, AND THE THINGS THAT WEREN'T SHATTERED BY THE INITIAL BLAST WERE DEMOLISHED AND RUINED BY THE FIRE. THANKS GO TO FAMILY AND NEIGHBORS FOR THIER BRAVERY AND STRENGTH TO GET EVERYONE OUT SAFELY.


