



The 10th Annual Derby Down the Deuce Race Starts at 8AM on July 9th 2022

- **Maximum 5' Width X 10' Length X 10' height.**
- **Cars must be Tandem two passenger (front and back seat, not side by side seating)**
- **Brakes and steering controls should be designated as two types:**
 - **Passenger (front seat) brakes and steering should be counterfeit, not having any real mechanical capabilities.**
 - **Driver (rear seat) brakes and steering should be working and effective in all respects. Cars must be able to steer while braking. Cars that brake the wheel must have brakes on each "side-by-side" set of wheels. Cars that brake the ground using friction must use rubber. No wood or metal ground pads**
- **It is highly recommended to keep the wheel dimensions to a max of 10". Larger wheels will tend to have increased speeds which is unnecessary with these special cars.**
- **Special needs cars are to have four wheels in contact with the ground at all times. No tricycles.**
- **Front (passenger) seat needs a four-point harness and cushioned seat to accommodate any special needs person.**
- **Derby car must be easily accessible for any disability**
- **Gravity driven**
- **Regarding overall design - Races start off a starting ramp which measures 12' long X 7' wide X 30" high. All cars must rest against the Starting Gate at the center of the ramp which measures 12"w. X 12"h. The front most part of your car must rest upon this gate. Attention should be given to low riding cars. If your car is too low and axles are placed inward you may bottom out**
