International Player, Master, Coach & Medalist my geographical reach includes representing India at the World Taekwondo Poomsae Championship in Hong Kong bagged 5th position, winning 1 Gold and 1 Bronze medal at the Hero Cup International Championship in Bangkok, and earning advanced international certificates from Kukkiwon as International Master and WT Level 1 Coach

Precedence

Describe any achievements in which the nominee was the first, the only one or have done uniquely?

My debut at the World Taekwondo Poomsae Championship in Hong Kong marked a historic milestone in my international sporting career. Representing India in the U-60 Pair Poomsae category, I competed against elite athletes from 13 countries and secured an impressive 5th position in my maiden World Championship appearance. I narrowly missed a podium finish by only 0.89 points, reflecting the exceptionally high standard of competition at the global level. Notably, this was the only top-ranking position secured by the 67-member Indian contingent at the championship, making the achievement particularly significant for Indian Taekwondo and a proud moment of national representation

How have the accomplishments been adopted or expanded?

My Taekwondo and sports models have been successfully scaled nationwide. Through the Air Force Wives Welfare Association (AFFWA), my martial arts instructional techniques were formally adopted across IAF bases. To expand access, Hawrang Academy grew from localized centers in Chennai and Bhadrak into a global online training platform. Structurally, as National Secretary of Veterans India Sports Wing, my administrative framework led to the establishment of dedicated sports wings across 27 States and Union Territories. Furthermore, my drafted 'Corruption-Free Sports Constitution' was presented to the Ministry to help standardize and elevate grassroots sports development across India.

Magnitude**Describe the work done by the nominee**

Dr. Ashok Kumar Lenka represents an extraordinary life of sacrifice, service and nation-building in which personal achievement has consistently remained secondary to the welfare of others and institutional excellence. From Tentuligadia village in Odisha to the Indian Air Force, and from a young martial arts instructor to a national sports leader, his life is defined by one unwavering principle: to use every skill, opportunity and moment in the service of others and the nation. His spirit of courage and service was evident from childhood. In 1981, while studying in Class VII at R.C.B.L. School, he risked his life to save his schoolmate, Sushil Kumar Puria, from the flooded Salandi River in Bhadrak. Later, in Class X, when a rabid dog terrorised his village and surrounding areas, he courageously confronted and killed the animal to protect the people of Tentuligadia. These early acts reflected the selfless core that would define his entire life. After joining the Indian Air Force on 10 July 1987, he devoted himself fully to his official duties while using his non-working hours for self-development and voluntary service. Beginning with his first posting, he voluntarily trained Air Warriors, their families and civilians in martial arts, Taekwondo, athletics, adventure, fitness and self-defence, largely without charging any fee. Through the Air Force Family Welfare Association (AFFWA), this service expanded across successive Air Force stations, particularly in remote areas. To date, more than three lakh individuals have benefited from these self-defence and fitness initiatives. His contribution directly strengthened the operational preparedness of the Indian Air Force. He trained Quick Reaction Teams at Air Force Station Awantipur, Officer Cadets at Air Force Technical College, Garud Commandos at Air Force Station Bhuj, Agniveers at Avadi, Police Trainees and Air Warriors in unarmed combat, self-defence and physical conditioning. His work demonstrated how martial arts and physical fitness serve national security by fostering discipline, resilience and combat readiness. His technical contributions were equally vital. At Training Centre 2, GWTI, he distinguished himself as an outstanding loader of the SAM-III system. At Air Force Technical College, Bengaluru, he contributed to the creation of nearly 100 video-based Computer-Based Training modules. Similar technical training resources were developed for 37 Squadron and 18 TETRA. At 37 Squadron, Air Force Station Nal, he proposed video-based debriefing of MiG-21 take-offs and landings—a pioneering initiative that enhanced flight safety awareness and contributed directly to reducing landing accident rates. During the Presidential Standard Presentation Parade of 48 Squadron and 37 Squadron at Bhuj, working with his Commanding Officer, Wing Commander P. Mohan, he made extensive contributions beyond his formal duties. These included parade-ground design, digitisation of historical MiG-21 museum photographs, President's exhibition material, media coverage, First Day Cover, coffee-table book, brochures and administrative correspondence, leaving behind a lasting historical record of IAF heritage. Following his military retirement, his service continued unabated. For the past 17 years, he has driven voluntary welfare work at Air Force Station Avadi through AFFWA. Through Taekwondo and sports mentorship, he has contributed to nearly 10,000 medal-winning performances at various levels and nurtured international competitors. K. Lokapradip achieved success at the Asian Championship, while Miss Saksham Yadav and Master Tejas Yadav secured Bronze Medals at the World Junior Championship. As their childhood coach and mentor, Dr. Lenka guided them from their formative years to international podiums. He and his students, including Lokapradip and Miss Harshini, have received high cash awards from the Sports Development Authority of Tamil Nadu. Representing India, he secured 5th position at the World Taekwondo Poomsae Championship. However, his ultimate achievement lies in converting his expertise into a sustainable mentorship ecosystem. As Honorary National Secretary of Veterans India Sports Wing, he drafted a transparent, corruption-free sports constitution under the vision "Rashtra Bhakti, Khel Se Shakti," implemented across 27 States and 22 disciplines. Its impact was demonstrated during the Global Patriotic Run on Republic Day 2021, when participants ran with the National Flag across every district of India and in 52 countries, earning recognition in the India Book of Records. The initiative received strong video endorsements from legends including Sachin Tendulkar, Abhinav Bindra, Manoj Kumar, Anju Bobby George, and Dilip Tirkey. For his sports leadership and service, he received the Pride of Nation Award in 2019 from Major General G.D. Bakshi and again on 16 December 2025 from the Hon'ble Minister of State for Defence, Shri Sanjay Seth. He has also been nominated by the Indian Air Force for the Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award for climbing 11 Himalayan peaks. His life journey is documented on his official websites (hawarangacademy.com and veteransindiasports.com), in Wings Beyond the Sky by Sergeant T.B. Rao, and in his forthcoming books The Mountain Warrior and The Mountain Way. Dr. Ashok Kumar Lenka's legacy is measured by the thousands of lives empowered, athletes nurtured, Air Warriors trained and patriotic spirit awakened—making him exceptionally deserving of the Padma Shri Award.

Dr. Lenka uniquely bridges elite international sports, military service, and nationwide grassroots development. As a retired IAF officer, he pioneered combat training for elite forces while securing India’s sole top-five finish at the World Taekwondo Poomsae Championship. His impact is distinctively structural: he scaled self-defense training to five lakh citizens via AFFWA, established sports wings across 27 States/UTs, and drafted a landmark 'Corruption-Free Sports Constitution'. Furthermore, his historic feat of practicing martial arts and sub-zero Tummo meditation across 11 Himalayan peaks showcases an unprecedented fusion of physical endurance, spiritual discipline, and patriotic dedication.

He is a Kukkiwon International Master Instructor, World Taekwondo Level-1 Coach (Kyorugi & Poomsae), National Referee and Coach. He has served as India Coach on two occasions, National Secretary, Veterans India Sports Wing; Vice President, Odisha Taekwondo; National Head, MAPL; and Taekwondo Tamil Nadu Coach. He represented India internationally and received official commendations from AFA Tamil Nadu and SDAT.

Through Hawrang Academy and his wider institutional initiatives, Dr. Lenka has created a sustained ecosystem of training, mentorship and social empowerment that has directly and indirectly benefited more than two lakh individuals. His work has helped young people develop discipline, confidence, physical fitness, leadership and a spirit of service, while enabling talented athletes from grassroots backgrounds to reach national and international platforms. His contribution to women's safety has been particularly significant. Through self-defence and empowerment programmes conducted in association with the Air Force Family Welfare Association, he has reached approximately five lakh students across nearly eleven States, helping women and girls acquire confidence, awareness and practical skills for personal safety. His work has taken self-defence beyond the martial arts arena and established it as an important instrument of social empowerment. Through decades of institutional service, coaching and mentorship, he has built a legacy of people empowered rather than merely medals won. His programmes have reached children, youth, women, students, service personnel, veterans and communities, using sport and martial arts as instruments of discipline, confidence, physical fitness, character-building and responsible citizenship. A major dimension of his social service has been women's safety and empowerment. Through his association with the Air Force Family Welfare Association (AFFWA), he conducted self-defence and empowerment programmes across nearly eleven States, benefiting approximately five lakh students, including a large number of girls and women. These initiatives provided practical skills, confidence and awareness for personal safety, particularly among those who otherwise had limited access to structured self-defence training.
