

# BAPTISM



## Baptism by Water

“Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.”

*Matthew 28:19, 20*

“For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.”

*Romans 10:10*

“And he (John the Baptist) came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.” *Luke 3:3* (There must be repentance from sin in order to be Baptized.)

Ananias said to Paul: “And now why tarriest thou

(Paul)? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord (Jesus).” *Acts 22:16*

**A baby cannot do this. Children are to be Given (dedicated) to the Lord by prayer, not baptized.**

“Therefore we are buried (Submersed under water) with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.” *Romans 6:4* (With a new and repentant heart.)

“Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.” *Colossians 2:12*

“Then the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this (Eunuch’s) chariot. And Philip ran thither to him, and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest? And he said, How can I, except some man should guide me? And he

desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him. The place of the scripture which he read was this, He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; and like a lamb dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth: In his humiliation his judgment was taken away: and who shall declare his generation? for his life is taken from the earth. And the eunuch answered Philip, and said, I pray thee, of whom speaketh the prophet this? of himself, or of some other man? Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus. And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized? And Philip said, **If thou believest with all thine heart**, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him. And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.” *Acts 29-39*

“Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.” *Matthew 28:19*

“He that **believeth** (first) **and is baptized** shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.” *Mark 16:16*

**Any one of my Born Again and baptized sons may baptize those that come unto me with a Believing and Repentant heart. (God’s words and God’s way.)**

**Any “church” leader who refuses to baptize a person because he does not belong to or want to join their group yet, is committing a very grievous sin. Do not hinder my sons and daughters from coming to me with your traditions.**

## Baptized in Fire

“And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.” *Acts 2:1-4*

The Gift of tongues is no longer. It was for the Jews only. Because the Jews required a sign. “For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people. To whom (Jews) he said, This is the rest wherewith ye may cause the weary to rest; and this is the refreshing: yet they would not hear.” *Isiah 28:11,12*

“Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that

believe, but to them that believe not: but prophesying serveth not for them that believe not, but for them which believe.” *1 Corinthians 14:22*

“If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.” *1 Corinthians 14:37*

At the Judgment: “If any man’s work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.” *1 Colossians 3:15*
