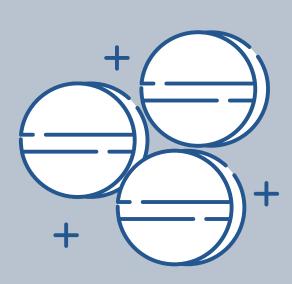
PSYCHOSIS FACT SHEET

About 100,000 adolescents and young adults in the US experience first episode psychosis each year.



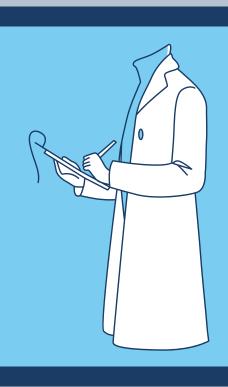


DIFFERENT PEOPLE AFFECTED

Psychosis can be a symptom of psychotic disorders, as well as: sleep deprivation, stress, certain prescription medications and substance use.

UNFORTUNATE PROGNOSIS

Consequences of untreated psychosis or psychotic disorders include: Worsening symptoms, Continual mental health decline, Being chronically ill, The need for daily support to handle psychosis





SUICIDE RATE

Psychotic disorders increase the risk of suicidal tendencies, particularly for people living with schizophrenia.

Between 5 and 10% of people with schizophrenia commit suicide.
