  - a. Discussion on ESD #3 in need of repairs. 2016 Grass Truck doesn't drive true and straight on highway. It has received some work that improved the driving, but it needs more.
  - b. Discussion/action on equipment needs by LVFD. Request for new light bar on Truck 360 at estimate cost of \$1,800. Motion by Hackworth to approve. Second by Tinsley. The motion carried.
  - c. Discussed the ESD #3 Web Site. Chief Gilliland shared information as to how a web site can be built and maintained by local people with the ability to do what is required. A motion by Hackworth to begin the work soon as possible. Second by Moore. Motion carried.
  - d. Discussed ESD#3 current policy is to allow up to \$2,500 on needed items. Greater than that amount needs approval of ESD #3 Commissioners next meeting.

- c. Discussion on fire calls in the area.

9. Chief Gilliland gave his report on the LVFD. They now have ok for increase in number of firemen to help in fire and related calls.
