

4 Nineteen Education & Training Policy/FAQ

- Reminders will be sent out before all classes.
- Classes are Non-refundable. Classes are Transferable up to 3 months of the missed class date for a class of the same value. If the class is less from the original class, no money will be reimbursed. If the class is more the student has to pay the remaining balance in order to register.
- If a student misses any days or hours out of the class they do not receive the certificate of completion for the class they missed. They will have to make up the class within 3 months or forfeit the class.
- If a student cancels for ANY reason the cancelation policy applies to reason including health and weather related issues.
- If Student asks for a refund, Student is responsible for any and all transaction fees.
- If you're on a payment plan and if your payment fails with the automatic withdrawals, no refund will be given. Same rules apply if you paid a deposit and an invoice for the balance is not paid by the due date.
- We accept cash, debit cards, and credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, Discover).
