

4 Nineteen Education & Training Policy/FAQ

- A \$100 deposit is to hold a place for the class(s). The balance is due 15 days after the
 deposit is paid and/or and 3 days before the class day depending on when the deposit
 was made.
- Reminders will be sent out before all classes.
- Classes are Non-Refundable 1 week before the class date and start time. Students can, however, switch to another class for the same value at another date and time up to a 3 month period from the original class day.
- If the same class is not available within the 3 months, you have two options.
 - 1. You'll forfeit the class.
 - 2. Take another class at a higher registration fee but you have to pay the difference or balance.
- There is a no-risk, 3 day period to cancel your registration and receive a full deposit refund for any reason.
- Students who cancel their registration after the 3-day period forfeit their \$100 deposit which is included in their partial payment and/or full payment.
- If Student asks for a refund, Student is responsible for any and all transaction fees
- We accept cash, debit cards, and credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, Discover).
- The total course fee includes all applicable course materials(handouts, manuals, and certificates of completion).
- If for any reason, the class is canceled by us, the whole course fee is refundable
 including the registration fee. In this scenario, students also have the option of
 transferring the paid fees to another course date.
