- 1. Township Board met July 8, approved 2024 soccer contract at Mitchell Park. Approved 7 community members for the Park Committee. Need to rewrite our Park Plan which has expired. Reviewed a quote for resurfacing parking lot. 2024 millage rate at 3.349 stayed the same was approved.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Next Era Beecher Solar Project -

McNamara gave an overview of this project. Last month held a Public Hearing for this project and with several residents comments. We asked for additional information from the applicant. Received it July 1, 2024. We had a consultant review this June 26, 2024 submittal and they issued a review with the project in order with the ordinances.

Steve Eastridge worked thru questions. Reference letter attached which addressed the following.

PA116 acres. 640 acres within the 837 acres. 433 fenced in acres.

Taxes

Panels – hail damage. Same as glass used in windshields and hurricane structures.

Migrant birds. Will not impact

Ground water impact. Does not present the needs for wells.

Wetlands – not anticipated to harm wetlands.

EMF interference – will not interfere with electric fields

Wind noise. In compliance with ordinance.

Panels fire. Built to state and federal requirements. Safety requirements will be put into place. Shut off either in person or remotely.

Landscaping – buffering made up of native Michigan species to grown 1-3 feet in a year. If a tree dies, replacement. Amended plan landscaping has been changed.

Road and Drain Commission. Has met with and see letter. Amended site plan Sign of professional.

Soil boring

Fencing

McNamara – lots of acres that won't have panels on them. Will they continue to be tilled after the infrastructure is completed? Eastridge – They will continue to be farming after the collection line is complete.

Witt – batteries? No proposal for this. Eastridge - Decommissioning bond, 3.5 million – concern between PA 116 and non PA116. MDARD will require a bond and Township will require a bond. Dan, attorney - MDARD does a bond and Township does a bond. Eastridge, they will have to carry two bonds. But willing to do hybrid bonds. Wants to make sure the Township and residents are covered. This bond issue has to be finalized before any permits are issued. Thanks for your detailed reports.

McNamara, OHM review dated June 26, 2024, point-by-point fact findings of Section 10.60 and this project is in compliance with the ordinances of the Township. Finding of Facts are listed in the OHM review. Site Plan revisions dated July 1, 2024.

PC reviewed OHM report covered the Section 10.60 Fact Findings. Comments on the applicants petition and responses positive. Applicant responded to all of the questions from Public Hearing.

Motion to: Approve based on Solar Farm Ordinance 10.70.22, OHM report dated June 26, 2024 and Site Plan dated July 1, 2024, and applicant's response dated July 2, 2024, application asking for Conditional Use Permit and Site Plan approval for Beecher Solar Project along with Finding of Facts as enumerated in OHM report items 1-6, and subject to review by outside agencies of Lenawee County Road Commission, Lenawee County Drain Commission, and contingent on EGLE / MDARD, written approvals.
