## I. JOB LOCATION




Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to ACT No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

1. One and two family dwellings when the total building heating/cooling system input rating is 375,000 BTU's or less.
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the mechanical inspector to be of a minor nature.
3. Business, Mercantile, and Storage buildings having HVAC equipment only, with one fire area and not more than $3,500 \mathrm{Sq}$. Ft.
4. Work completed by a government subdivision or state agency costing less than $\$ 15,000$

Plans must be submitted if you do not qualify for one of the exemptions listed above before a permit can be issued.
