9.2 FOIA Denial Appeal: On July 17, 2026, FOIA request 26-15 was received from Sean Murphy requesting a PDF copy of a background check performed on McDonald prior to his appointment, either as a trustee or ordinance enforcement officer. On July 23, 2026, a Notice of Denial of FOIA Request was sent to Mr. Murphy citing the information is exempt from disclosure based on MCL 15.243 (1) (a) Invasion of Privacy and MCL 15.243 (1) (d) Exempt from Disclosure By Statute. Mr. Murphy filed an Appeal of Denial.

McDonald requested to be recused from the discussion. Motion Bunch, Support Hunt to accept McDonald's request.

Mr. Murphy was not present. Township Board members received an email from Mr. Murphy expressing his position. The FOIA request, FOIA denial, and Mr. Murphy's communications were reviewed by the Board of Trustees. Motion Brousseau, Support D. Witt to uphold the FOIA Denial.
