I, Lilia DuBois, make this affidavit in support of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts'

Motion for Preliminary Injunction.

- I am an attorney admitted in Massachusetts am currently employed as an Assistant
 Attorney General at the Massachusetts Attorney General's Office (the "AGO"). I submit
 this affidavit to place before the Court certain facts and documents referred to in the
 Commonwealth of Massachusetts' Memorandum in Support of its Motion for
 Preliminary Injunction.
- 2. As part of the AGO's investigation of the investment scam operated by Defendant, ASX a/k/a "Renderbitget" ("ASX"), the AGO traced fraudulently obtained funds to one Binance.com ("Binance") wallet ending in -7067 (the "Binance Wallet") and to two unhosted wallets ending in -3FE3 and -396a (the "Unhosted Wallets"). The Unhosted Wallets contain Tether coins, also known as "USDT," the smart contracts for which are managed by Tether Limited.

- On April 9, 2025, the AGO requested that Tether Limited blacklist or freeze USDT in the Wallets ending in -3FE3 and -396a to prevent scammers from absconding with the funds and to allow the AGO to obtain a court order.
- On April 14, 2025, Tether Limited notified the AGO that it had placed a courtesy temporary freeze on the Unhosted Wallets.
- On April 15, 2025, the AGO requested that Binance freeze USDT in a Wallet ending in -7067 to prevent scammers from absconding with the funds and to allow the AGO to obtain a court order.
- On April 17, 2025, Binance granted a courtesy temporary freeze that is set to expire on May 19, 2025.
