**Run No.** The Decedent's ID number (assigned when the case is established)

**Time** Start time of the committal service (services are scheduled on the hour and half-hour and are generally no more than 20 minutes)

**Decedent** Individual being interred

**Sect** Section where interment will take place  
 1, 2, 3, 7, 8, 9 & 20 - traditional side-by-side graves - upright headstone  
 6, 12, 14 & 21 (4, 5, & 15 future sections) - pre-placed crypts, remains are placed one on top of the other (a shelf in between) within the same liner/crypt - upright headstone  
 CA, CB, CC & CW - Columbarium Walls - niche cover  
 G1-G32, 18 & 19 (10 future section) - in-ground cremation - flat marker

**Grave** Specific grave within a section where the interment will take place

**F/S** First/Subsequent - First = initial interment - Subsequent = any interment after the initial interment

**Dpth** Depth - Depth in which the interment takes place  
 Traditional / Side-by-Side - **5ft** (if more than 2 interments will take place, the 1st interment will be @ 7ft)  
 Pre-Placed Crypts - **7ft** (1st interment) **5ft** (2nd interment)  
 Columbariums - **0**  
 In-ground cremations - **3ft**

**Pos** Position - Location within the grave where the Decedent is placed  
 Traditional / Side-by-Side - **RH** - Right Half (1st interment) **LH** - Left Half (2nd interment)  
 Pre-Placed Crypts - **BH** - Bottom Half (1st interment) **TH** - Top Half (2nd interment)  
 Columbariums - **NA**

In-ground cremations - **CL** - Center Line

**Cont** Container - Type of container that is used for the interment  
Traditional / Side-by-Side - **GL2** - Gov't Liner (provided by cemetery) **PV2** - Private Vault (purchased by family)  
Pre-Placed Crypts - **GP9** - Gov't Pre-Placed Crypt (already in the ground for entire section)  
Columbariums - **PV7** - Urn  
In-ground cremations - **PV7** - Urn **PV6** - Urn w/Urn Vault

**Rel** Relationship - Relationship of the Decedent to the Veteran  
**V** - Veteran **W** - Wife **H** - Husband **D** - Minor Daughter **S** - Minor Son **A** - Ad Dep Dau **B** - Ad Dep Son

**Act** Action - How the Decedent is being laid to rest  
**I** - Service **T** - Direct Interment **D** - Disinterment **R** - Reinterment\* **S** - Service Only (not interred)  
\* This occurs when we have to move cremains from the columbarium to a casket site at time of subsequent interment

**Shltr** Shelter - Location of the commital service - currently 2 shelters

**Rep** Cem Rep - do not fill this in

**Clgy** Clergy - will cemetery be providing clergy - this is always "N" (no)

**Hnrs** Honors - has honors been requested, if so what honors detail will be present (cemetery honors are on station for all services unless active duty provides a full detail)  
**NR** - None Requested **CH** - Cemetery Honors **AR** - Army **MC** - Marine Corps **NA** - Navy **AF** - Air Force **CG** - Coast Guard

**P-Vlt** Private Vault - Has the family purchased a private vault

Additional Notes: Often times the Rep will add notes to the "remarks" line to indicate something out of the ordinary

- "Cre on Stat" - Cremains are on station - the caretakers can pick up the cremains from the main office for a direct interment or the Rep will carry the urn with them to the service
- "PGR" - Patriot Guard Riders will be present at the service
- "No Fun.Dir." - The family is bringing the cremains to the cemetery, there will be no funeral director coming
- "Fam to View" - Family has requested to witness the interment, this is only allowed for cremation interments (casket interments can be watched from the road)
- "Comp Urn" or "2 Urns" - Companion urn or 2 individual urns - when both the veteran and spouse are interred at the same time
