February	Toys and Wow Items (shoebox size and also backpack size): dolls, toy cars, stuffed animals, soccer balls or footballs or basketballs (deflated) w/pump, yo-yos, Slinkys, games, puzzles, small purses or change purses, building blocks/Lego kits, wallet, wristwatch, costume jewelry, jump ropes, sidewalk chalk, card games, small tool kits, fishing gear, books, magazines (hunting, fishing, sports for backpacks), ear buds (backpacks), small travel-size hair dryers (backpacks), hat (like ball caps w/adjustable straps – backpacks), binoculars, compass, small musical instruments, plastic animals or figurines
