ORDINANCE 2023-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MELBOURNE VILLAGE, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, SECTION 2-18 OF THE MELBOURNE VILLAGE CODE: **AMENDING** THE CODE **ENFORCEMENT BOARD** COMPOSITION, TERMS, REMOVAL, AND ORGANIZATION; AMENDING **CHAPTER** 23, **SECTION** 23-17 OF MELBOURNE VILLAGE CODE: AMENDING THE TOWN REVIEW **BOARD COMPOSITION: PROVIDING FOR** SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Melbourne Village has previously adopted Chapter 2, Section 2-18 and Chapter 23, Section 17 of the Melbourne Village Code; and

WHEREAS, the Town population is less than 5,000 persons, and is therefore allowed by section 162.5, Florida Statutes, to appoint a five-member code enforcement board rather than the seven board members require by current code; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to reduce the code enforcement board membership from seven members to five members, and to eliminate the recommended membership experience; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to reduce the town review board membership from nine members to five members, and to eliminate the composition requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission finds that these changes are in the best interest of the Town of Melbourne Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF MELBOURNE VILLAGE, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

<u>SECTION 1: SECTION 2-18. CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD CREATED;</u> <u>COMPOSITION; TERMS; REMOVAL; ORGANIZATION.</u>

(1) The Town Commission shall appoint a five-member Code Enforcement Board whose members are and have been residents of the town twelve (12) months immediately preceding appointment and shall serve without compensation. The Board shall also include one alternate member, who shall attend all meetings and may participate in discussion, but who will only vote when one of the regular members of the Board is absent. The alternate member shall be appointed to a three-year term.

- (2) The initial appointments to the board shall be as follows:
 - (a) One (1) member appointed for a term of one (1) year each.
 - (b) Two (2) members appointed for a term of two (2) years each.
 - (c) Two (2) members appointed for a term of three (3) years each.

Thereafter, any appointment shall be made for a term of three (3) years. A member may be reappointed by the town commission for one successive term. Any appointment to fill any vacancy on the board shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term of office. If any member fails to attend two of three successive meetings without cause and without prior approval of the Chairperson, the board shall declare the member's office vacant and the town commission shall promptly fill such vacancy. Members may be suspended and removed for cause by the town commission.

- (3) At the first meeting of the Code Enforcement Board the members shall elect a Chairperson and Secretary from among the board members. The presence of three (3) or more members shall constitute a quorum necessary to conduct board business.
- (4) The board shall establish a schedule for regular meetings at such intervals as the board may determine, and regular meetings may be cancelled by the Chairperson if no cases are pending or necessary business is to come before the board. Special meetings may be convened by the Chairperson, or the Secretary in the absence of the Chairperson, upon giving thereof to each member of the board and the Town Clerk at least seventy-two (72) hours notice in advance.
- (5) Minutes shall be maintained of all meetings and hearings held by the board, and all meetings, hearings, and proceedings shall be open to the public.
- (6) The town attorney shall either be counsel to the enforcement board or shall represent the town by presenting cases before the enforcement board, but in no case shall the town attorney serve in both capacities, and in the event the town attorney acts as counsel to the enforcement board, the code enforcement officer shall represent the town by presenting cases before the board. The town commission may appoint a practicing member of the Florida Bar to represent the board when required, to be compensated by the town.

SECTION 2: SECTION 23-17. TOWN REVIEW BOARD.

(1) The Town Review Board shall consist of five (5) members with one alternate nominated by the Mayor and appointed by the Town Commission. It shall include a Chairperson and a Secretary elected from and by the membership of the Board. The presence of three (3) or more members shall constitute a quorum necessary to conduct board business.

SEVERABILITY: If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or subsection of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections, or subsections of this Ordinance.

CONFLICTS: All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict with this Ordinance.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the Town Commission of the Town of Melbourne Village on the first reading this 25 day of April, 2023, and upon its second reading this 23 day of May, 2023.
