III Hiring of Town Clerk/Treasurer. Desiree Hayes was introduced by Mayor Salmon. Kim Zarillo and Peter McCharles spoke endorsing Mrs. Hayes. **Motion** by Commr Murphy to hire Desiree Hayes at \$45,000 per year with standard benefits, including health insurance coverage effective 19 Nov 2020. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commr Calenda. Voting yes were Commrs Anderson, Calenda, Jones, Murphy, Sinton, VM Carroll and Mayor Salmon. Voting no were none. Vote was 7 Yes, 0 No. **Motion approved.**


Public hearing closed at 7:50PM.
