<b>Pre-Event</b>	Call or go door to door to check on neighbors Complete checklist Report up the chain	<i>Need help to prepare?</i> <i>Special needs such as medical equipment?</i>
<b>Post-Event</b>	Call or go door to door to check on neighbors Identify residents who need help Note damage to houses or other property (FEMA) Pass on info: Town and AHF open (AC, power, WIFI) Report up the chain Help coordinate response as needed Communication is primary responsibility	<i>Driveways or doors blocked</i> <i>Flooding</i> <i>Trees falling on house, flooding inside house</i> <i>Power</i> <i>Health needs</i> <i>Need help with clean up?</i> <i>Residents should go to AHF Hall with requests</i>
