- b) Emergency Management Plan Outline – Vice Mayor Foster stated the latest track of Hurricane Milton and the closures in place with schools, government, etc. Vice Mayor Foster asked the Commission their opinion regarding closing Town Hall for the Hurricane, as well as coordinating with Mayor Ditty for coverage of the town office. The Commissioners discussed and decided they would be able to cover the office and to close Town Hall on Wednesday, October 9<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, October 10<sup>th</sup>


