PART 1: IMMIGRANT LETTER

DESCRIPTION:

You are an immigrant from Russia and today is the one-year anniversary of your arrival to the United States. You arrived at Ellis Island with your wife (or husband), two children, mother and sister and had left your father and older brother back in Russia. You had left Russia because of lack of work, impoverish conditions and you and your family had been persecuted by the Czar's police because of your religion. Unfortunately, both your mother and sister were sent back to Russia when you all arrived at Ellis Island due to their poor medical condition. Note: Being a personal letter you can use "I".

REQUIREMENTS:

Write a letter to your sister who was sent back who has now returned to Russia. Using the concepts we have discussed in class this past week, use this letter to:

- Explain how life has been for you and your children the past year (problems and good things)
- What type of work you have been doing
- What are your feelings about Russia and America
- What are your feelings about both your families in Russia and America?

Specific Letter Requirements:

1. At least 25 sentences in length

Locate a news article since August 1, 2020 dealing with the issue of immigration in 2020. Write a typed report summarizing the article and explaining how the article relates to immigration by answering the following

- 1. What topic (s) covered in the immigration unit does your article address (Bulleted)
- 2. List the current issues, controversies and/or questions your article addresses (Bulleted)
- 3. Article Report
 - Provide a <u>brief</u> summary of the article
 - How does the article relate to these topics bulleted in Question #1? (Be specific)
 - How does the article deal with the issues & controversies bulleted in Question #2 (Be Specific)
 - What is your general opinion about the article, these issues mentioned and the immigration issue in 2020 in general
