DAILY FACT	The war had changed America profoundly. "The contest touches everything and leaves nothing as it found it", wrote <i>The New York Times</i> in 1867. Great rights, great interests, great systems of habit and of thought disappear during its progress. It leaves us a different people in everything. Two years later, George Ticknor, of Harvard, observed the war had opened a "great gulf between what happened before in our century and what has happened since, or what is likely to happen in the hereafter.
