

BFPC BOD Meeting Minutes

March 31, 2026

All 7 board members are in attendance.

1. Approval of minutes from February 24, 2026; ALC approved; KL seconded
2. **Membership Update & Communications**; KL: 426 members...we are on target from last year. The Bulletin Board at both court locations will be updated in early April, as well as an email blast, with new information regarding beginner/intermediate lessons. Any member from BFPC can make posts on our FB page.
3. **Treasury Report**; AC: Accounting matches membership numbers. Per an email from AC...our bank balance at the end of the month of March was \$10969.55. The Elia has cashed our deposit check in the amount of \$750.
4. **Maintenance**; DS: The wall, at the FC, in the tennis court area used for pickleball practice needs to be repaired. A repair request ticket will be submitted. The gate at the same court is broken – DS will repair. Brooms at both court locations are being repaired or replaced.
5. **Programs**; SG/TT: Shark 4.0 /Barracuda 3.5 challenge will be run by Eric Hoffman. They will be held on 2 different days; Friday, April 24th and Saturday, April 25th. Programs will handle email communications/sign-ups for Mother's Day and Father's Day events. There was some confusion with canceling RR/SKD due to the weather. We will make sure to communicate changes via email blast and FB.
6. **Vice President**; WR: Dinko De Mayo will be held on May 5 from 4p-7p at the FC. We will be changing caterers to Aye Toro. Sign-up to play will be in the same format as last year. The price will be \$12pp with a \$400 budget. DS will locate the portable nets and tape the tennis court. WR will be asking Laurie Dever and/or

Kim Mihan about setting up a demo table at this event. Muffins for Moms will be Saturday, 5/9 from 9a-11:30a. Dad's event will be Friday, 6/19 from 6p-9p. Both will be free to the membership, and each will be allotted a \$400 budget. The HOP Summer Social will be Saturday, 8/22 from 6p-9:30p. Facility rental is \$900/4 hours. Admission of \$15 will offer 3.5 hours of play, 2 slices of pizza, and dessert and a DJ. A max of 125 people will be set. Play format will be paddle stacking. The Holiday Party deposit of \$750 was sent to the Elia. The final contract is being negotiated. A final count needs to be given 2 weeks before the event date of December 1st. We will cap the admission of 150 members.
