BFPC BOARD MEETING MINUTES

4:00 pm; May 10th, 2023

Meeting called to order by Sandi at 4:00pm.

In attendance: Sandi, Kim, Laurie, Bob, Joe and Amy. Excused: Dave.

Joe assigned to take minutes.

Motion to approve minutes from last meeting by Amy, seconded by Kim; Passed unanimously.

Sandi reported that the FC courts would be open on Friday Morning and that we should go and inspect them to look at the lines. She is trying to get the Cape Fear courts resurfaced this year, also.

She also reported that the Inter-community League would be holding a party at Cape Fear on May 24th from 4:00 to 8:00 pm. She has posted a sign there.

Kim noted the Dinko de Mayo party was a success and good feedback was received. She has pictures that she will post. This segued into a discussion on the upcoming pool party. Laurie asked if we had music at the party last year and should we do so this year. We discussed the price, which was @20/pp last year. It was decided we will try to get the price down. We have sufficient monies in our account to subsidize it without going over budget. No final decision was made. We have 501 people in the club now, last year there was about 133 people at the party (Sandi wasn't sure and will check). We talked about capping the attendance at 200 maximum. We said the party should start at 4:00 with food at 4:30. Laurie will be interviewing caterers. Expected cost is about \$17:00/pp. We discussed music and Laurie will look into that, also. Date confirmed as August 16. (subsequent to the meeting, texts noted, and agreed on, registration to the pool party will start on August 1st and go to August 10th).

Bob report that 20 new Franklin X balls were delivered to Cape Fear today. There were also 28 Onix balls. The high level players all seem to prefer the Franklin X but they don't last as long. Bob has gathered all the defective oange balls and will be returning them. Amy has the return label for him.

Joe reported that Round Robin last night had only 5 Hot and Spicy (3.0) players in the 7:00pm spot and was canceled. We frequently have problems getting players in that time slot.

Dave is away until the 20th. Joe will set up the Skatter day this week and deliver the score sheets. If Dave is not back for the 20th, he'll do that one, too. Sandi will oversee this coming Round Robin as Joe is away. Scorekeepers are arranged for the month for both activities, so there should be no problems.

Amy reported that the Bank balance is \$15,500. PayPal registrations and the membership list ties out We now have 501 members.

Approximate cost to the Club for the Dinko de Mayo party was \$2,000. This is within our budget.

The next meeting of the Board will be 4:00 pm on June 21st. We will meet in the area under the overhang by the pool.
