

## BFPC BOD Meeting Minutes

February 24, 2026

Meeting start: 12:10 pm; meeting adjourned 1:16 pm

6 board members are in attendance. SG absent. +Gordon Reed, CFIL rep.

1. Approval of minutes from January 27, 2026; KL approved; AC seconded
2. **Membership Update & Communications**; KL: 359 members to date. KL and GR (from CFIL) are currently making sure all CFIL players are members.
3. **Treasury Report**; AC: Accounting matches membership ~\$9100 to date. PayPal deposit was made to account. Reminder to submit receipts if paying out of pocket.
4. **Maintenance**; DS: Rollers and holders have been delivered but yet to be installed at both court locations. As of today, they are still not up. Tiffany has been notified of the many cracks at both court locations. Lighting is still an issue; options are being investigated by CAMS. New balls were given to CFIL, RR and SKD. New blowers were purchased and are now in the locked bins at each court location. A discussion regarding mesh on CF fencing as to which side should it be on. BOD left it to the discretion of DS.
5. **Programs**; TT: The first spring clinic is scheduled for March 7<sup>th</sup>. Skatter Days starts March 14; Round Robin starts March 17. TT will assist SG in all program activities. We will consider bringing the ball machine to social play.
6. **Vice President**; WR: PB Appreciation Day is set for Feb 28 from 10a-12p. BOD not needed to volunteer but please show up so ALC can introduce and be a face to many new members. Dave Gyr will have a paddle exchange table set up. Dinko DeMayo will be on May 5<sup>th</sup> at FC and other local catering options are being vetted for this event. WR has asked her social committee for one co-lead for each event. Muffins for Moms is May 9<sup>th</sup>. Ideas were presented for a Father's Day

event such as a Happy Hour on the Friday before, June 19<sup>th</sup>. WR will be meeting with the HOP to coordinate an August date for our summer event. Dink for Pink will be Oct 17<sup>th</sup>; rain date is Oct 18<sup>th</sup>.

7. **President**: ALC: Proposed an idea of renting bus for a 'field trip' to a pickleball tournament. This may not be possible this spring, but she will investigate and report back. Alcohol at events has been clarified by CAMS. Alcohol can be advertised and provided for events as long as we don't charge for the alcohol. Per Cams, cameras, for now, are still a no.

8. **Other Business**: BOD picture taken for the website.

\* Gordon Reed CFIL rep attended. 104 players - 32 Social (2 teams), 28 Intermediate, 20 Upper Intermediate, 22 Advanced. Shawn O'Conner will coach the UI team. Amy B. will assist Gordon again this season. \$118.26 was refunded from CFIL for past entry fees. \$125 requested from BOD to purchase snacks for home games. Brenda Morrison is the new CFIL Director. Advanced teams will play hybrid matches: 4 competitive/3 social games. 50 DUPR games are still required for all teams excluding the Advanced team. BF CFIL will not be offering DUPR events as there are many opportunities within the community at other facilities.
