

BFPC BOD Meeting Minutes

August 25, 2025

Meeting start: 3:00 pm; meeting adjourned 4:15 pm

All 7 board members in attendance.

1. Approval of minutes from July 7, 2025; BL approved; KL seconded
2. **Membership Update & Communications**; KL, count on current members list is 492 members. Event registration needs to have a hard close date. NO paying at the door and NO refunds. Save The Date for Dink for Pink will go out
3. **Treasury Report**; AC, accounting matches membership numbers. Adding \$278 to account from PayPal. Approx \$8400 after the HOP event which brought in about \$1650 (110people x\$15). We renewed our Go Daddy account for 3 years \$1k+. We are looking good financially. How lean do we want to be at years end How much can/do we want to subsidize the Holiday Party for members?
4. **Maintenance**; EH, FC:12 broken 8 were Selkirk. CFN:47 broken 3 Selkirk. Distributed: 41 to FC, 0 to CFN. Balance 42 as of 8/25. Sent 80 balls back on warranty received 78. Random big, holed balls are being left in the bins at FC...removed 10+ in a week. Ordered 100 new balls. Distributed 48 to Programs for RR/SD and 40 to ICC. Upgraded all fan controls to on/off switches to eliminate pull cord breakage.
5. **Programs**: MM: Ladder League had 47 people at the interest meeting. Advance will start 9/3 @10am Intermediate will start 9/5@10. Season will go for 6 weeks. It will be similar to Skatter Day scoring. Beginners Clinic will be 9/6, 8am-12pm, Laurie D will facilitate. 2 levels: beginner and 3.0. Round Robin begins 9/9, Skatter Day begins 9/13. Scorekeeper email invites will be out 1st week in September. TT: members asked if the club would offer any DUPR opportunities for members. 2 were offered, 1 poorly attended so 2nd was cancelled. Maybe try again next year.

6. **Vice President:** ALC: HOP event was a success. A lot of volunteers were used. Paddle stacking was a bit confusing, but it worked itself out. Definitely think about this for next year. ACL proposed an idea to attend/organize a Pro Pickleball tournament trip in NC next year. TT: Dink for Pink is Oct 11 at CFN 8am-12pm. No rain date. Proposed doing a marathon event, 400 games in 4 hours. Paddle stacking in lieu of time sign-ups. Lots of volunteers needed. Door prizes, snacks, refreshments and music. 100% of registration will go to Making Strides Against Breast Cancer. Tables and chairs have been requested from CAMs. \$500 budget was approved. Holiday party December 3rd. Venue is booked. Working on menu same or change it up? Registration opens in early November, closes before Thanksgiving. Open for 2 weeks. Volunteer appreciation party will be invitation only (through EVITE) on a Sunday morning breakfast/play in November. November 8, 9am-11am at CFN. BOD is encouraged to be available. \$500 budget approved.

7. **President:** BL: We have 3 coaches for beginner social intercommunity league. Laurie D, Steve G, and Joanne E. CAMs will be getting new tables, chairs, and umbrellas for CFN. Theres 1 new umbrella so far. We need to look for a Nominating committee soon and start recruiting people for the open positions for next year. BL invited ACL to accompany him at the next FC meeting in September.

8. **Other Business:** There was a safety issue on the fence the FC. A member got his shoe caught on the bottom of the fence. It's been fixed.
