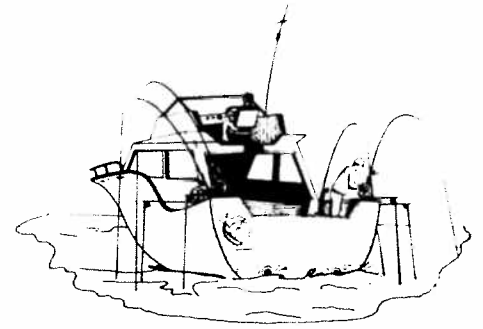

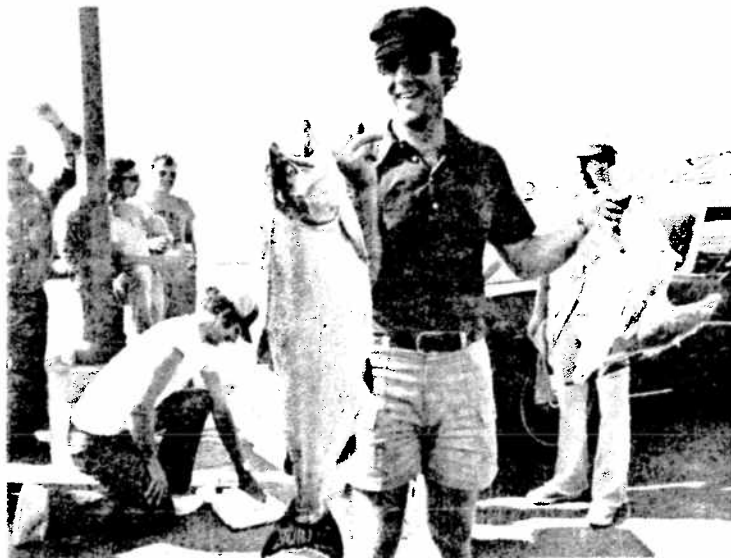
1. Check your address on the newsletter to see if name and address and zip are correct, if not call Jim Boyer, 542-9073.
