

Austin Fishin' Was Tough But Surprising!

For the first time since 2009, (8) crews & their lb. walleye. Skipper John Meade of the õSalukiö boats descended upon the sleepy village of Port Austin for a DAS Boat Trolling tournament on Saturday, July 30. However, with the wind blowing pretty good out of the E-NE and waves in the 3ø to 4ø range offshore as forecasted, it was decided at the 5:00am Skipperøs meeting to wait & see how bad things really were in daylight. Co-Tournament director Bob Ksionzek asked the crews to re-convene at 8:30am to see if some sort

of tournament would be possible.

Meanwhile, Co-Tournament director Bob Feisel & crew took a boat ride out to the Port Austin lighthouse in Bobøs õVickieøs Seacretö to do an on-the-water assessment. They confirmed conditions as a 2ø-3ø chop with widely spaced 4ø rollers out beyond the PA light. With



The walleye fishing had been very good the previous 2 weeks but this big blow out of the E-NE had cooled down the water 7 to 10 degrees and walleye were pretty hard to find. But surprisingly, the DAS fleet were catching some õsilveröfish. Tournament director Bob Ksionzek made an on the water decision to add a 2nd \$5 Big Fish pool for Salmon & Trout. At the 11:30am Fish Call, all boats reported at least one fish. õBobbyøs Toyö had 2 steelhead and 1 coho, õ

Prior to the outing weigh-in, the crews enjoyed the delicious pizza and fresh ante pasta salad from Joe

Pizzeria in town as well as cookies and the usual assortment of cold drinks. All boats weighed at least 1 fish. Only 2 walleye were weighed-in and õDianaøs Denö skippered by Dennis Harper managed to take the \$40 Big Walleye pool with a 2.8

team took the Big Trout-Salmon pool with a 6.6 lb. steelhead which won the \$40 also.

Based on the forecast of lesser winds and waves 2ø or under, it was decided to have the regular tournament Sunday morning starting at 6:00am with no Skipperøs meeting. We would fish until 11:00am with one Fish Call at 9:00am. The weigh-in would be at the same place at 12:00pm., unfortunately

> John Meade had prior commitments on Sunday and could not stick around. Bob Feisel had re-occurring boat issues and decided he could fish not and put õVickieøs Seacretö on the trailer and headed home. So we were down to 6 boats for Sundayøs event.

Sunday morning the waves were more like 2\psi 3\psi but it was very fishable with all 6 boats on the water for the 6:00am roll call. õDianaøs Denö being the smallest

boat and õSea Hagö were chosen as weather boats in case things got worse and a decision to continue fishing was needed. It stayed fishable all morning and most boats headed 4 to 5 miles off the PA light at about 30 degrees to fish the reef for lake trout. The better fishing was in 100 to 120 FOW but the lake trout that are usually in abundance here were hard to come by. But 5 of 6 boats brought some fish to the weigh-in including steelhead, coho, a few lakers and even a king!

Skipper Bob Jones and his crew on õBobbyøs Toyö brought 7 fish to the weigh-in but only 5 could be counted. However, those 5 were good for 57.05 pts and 1st Place. Congratulations, õBobbyœs Toyö! õSea Hagö with skipper Blaise Pewinski and crew weighed-in (2) lake trout, numbers well below his usual catch here, but they took 2nd place honors with 35.85 pts. Team õTygerö skippered by Ty Voigt brought a coho and a lake trout to the scales good for 23.40 pts and 3rd place. Big Fish was a 16.25 lb. King caught aboard õBobbyøs Toyö by Rod Elnick. Nice, especially for Port Austin!

We had a great showing of boats including 2 new ones, Moonshot & Trapshooter at the Manistee Tournament this past Saturday, August 13. The weather and lake conditions were also great. The fish were pretty cooperative especially considering how poor the spring and early summer was for kings and surprisingly the kings were big! Every boat caught fish and once again, Skipper Bob Paradise and his "Almost Paradise" crew prevailed at his home port with the best catch & 1st place. Congratulations to the "Almost Paradise" team!

Port Captain Tom Gorguze decided to shake up the Big Fish pool by raising it to \$5 a piece for Big King, Big Steelhead, Big Lake Trout & Best Box. Jason Adam fishing aboard "Bad Dog" with Skipper Tom Gorguze caught a dandy bruiser of a King that weighed 24.9 lbs. good for \$60 bucks. Because no one weighed-in a Steelhead or Lake Trout that money was rolled into the Big Box pool and paid \$180 to The "Almost Paradise" crew!

The fishing was good all along the shelf in 100 to 180 FOW from Manistee all the way down to Big Sable Point. Flashers & flies & J-plugs seemed to work the best off the riggers down 50' to 70'. Inline planers with 5 to 10 colors of lead or 200' to 300' of copper were catching fish too. But the bite was definitely early and most boats caught very few fish after 9:00 am.

Port Captain Tom Gorguze (actually his wife Diane) prepared a great meal of Sloppy Joes, fresh tomatoes, Corn on the cob, Potato salad and Charlie Denning had his usual delicious cupcakes for the weigh-in luncheon along with plenty of cold pop & water. New Proposals on Lake Michigan Proposed Stocking Cuts

Since the Lake Michigan Committee (LMC) proposal to reduce Chinook salmon stocking by 62%, each agency has received consistent feedback from stakeholders that we should consider lake trout stocking reductions along with our proposal and not reduce the full 62% of Chinook salmon. We also heard of angler interest to increase harvest opportunity for lake trout. Below are proposals that the LMC has agreed to:

Regulations

- Wisconsin, Indiana and Illinois will pursue an increased lake trout bag limit from 2 fish per day to 3 fish per day. This will align with Michiganøs regulations of 3 fish per day in MM6-8.
- Michigan will pursue a possession season of open all year of for MM6-8 to align with Wisconsin, Indiana, and Illinois.
- Michigan will also pursue opening drowned river mouth lakes that currently have a closed season.

Chinook Stocking Reduction Alternative

• A new proposal for a Chinook salmon stocking reduction is to only reduce stocking by 50% of current levels. The new proposal is described in the table below. Under this alternative proposal, Michiganøs Chinook stocking would go from 560,000 to 300,000, which would be a reduction of 46% from current levels.

Lake Trout Stocking Reduction

The total lake trout stocking in yearling equivalents averaged about 3,190,000 in recent years. The proposal would reduce stocking to 2,540,000, which is about a 21% reduction in lake trout lake-wide. All reductions will be outside the 1836 Consent Decree waters until a plan for further lake trout reductions can be reviewed and approved by the consent decree Technical Fisheries Committee.

The lake trout reduction includes discontinuation of 550,000 fall fingerling (220,000 yearling equivalents) lake trout stocking that was approved by the LMC in 2015 and implemented in 2016.

Lake Michigan proposed stocking cuts

The Mid-Lake Reef Complex (Sheboygan, Northeast, and Milwaukee reefs) will be reduced by 300,000 or 50%.

Second priority lake trout stocking sites outside consent decree waters will be reduced 100%. This includes Grand Haven (20,000), Holland (40,000), New Buffalo (20,000), Michigan City (40,000), Sturgeon Bay (80,000), Kewaunee (20,000), and Wind Point (50,000).

Future lake trout stocking changes will depend on negotiations with the 1836 Tribal Nations. We will propose to reduce all second priority stocking sites from Grand Haven to the north including Ludington, Manistee, Pointe Betsie, Good Harbor, Old Mission, Grand Traverse Bay Shoal, Torch Lake and Elk Rapids. If that plan is approved, we could redistribute some lake trout to areas that were reduced 100% to maintain nearshore fisheries.

The Michigan Marquette State Fish Hatchery raises about 49,500 lake trout for Grand Haven, Holland, and New Buffalo. We will continue to stock those fish with New Buffalo receiving 12,500 and Grand Haven and Holland each receiving 18,500.

The Lake Michigan Committee will more formally include lake trout management in future stocking decisions to help achieve predator and prey balance in Lake Michigan and also meet rehabilitation goals.
