of boats with 8 including 21 new ones - "Just Wastin' Time with Skipper Don Jasmin and "Lake Buzzard IV" and Skipper Fred Chartier. A Big Welcome to the new guys and Crews.

Bob Paradise and crew weigh-ed in 13 (they caught 15), their best 8 was good for 137.85 points compared to 2nd place boat, "Bad Dog" who weigh-ed in 5 fish for 89.8 points. We also had a repeat fish-off (1st one was last year) with the Flint River Valley Steelheaders (FRVS). They had a good showing of 12 boats. Good bunch of guys led by

their tournament chairmen Randy Bailey. But the DAS guys did it again, by a much closer margin than last year, with a total weight of 290 lbs to the FRVS's 267.1 lbs. From each club, we used each of the top 5 boats best 5 fish and added the weight up for the totals. So the travelling trophy remains in our hands for this year. Congratulations DAS for another win! Thanks to the Flint River Valley guys! Everyone is looking forward to next year's rematch!




