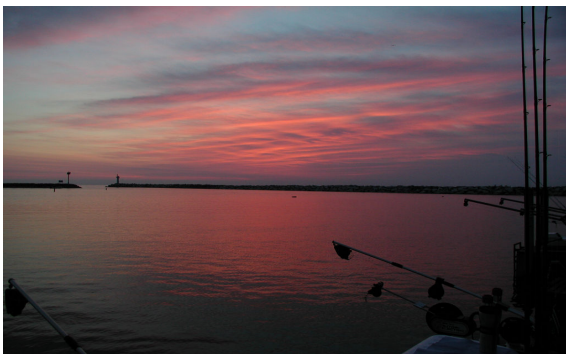
February 2009 Meeting

New Club President Mark Williams opened the meeting at our new meeting location in the archery range upstairs at Bass Pro Shop in Auburn Hills promptly at 7:30 pm. A good turnout of 59 members and guests were on hand to check out the new location. Mark immediately informed everyone that the meetings would have to be held in a very timely manner while Bass Pro Shop has their winter closing time of 9:00 pm in effect. Once they return to their Spring & Summer Hours and close at 10:00pm we would have more time available.

Mark also informed every one about the Bass Pro Shop 10% discount certificates available to all members attending the day of the meeting. He went on to introduce Bob Mitchell as the new Vice-President as well as Joe VonGrabe returning as Secretary and Steve Hamilton returning as Treasurer. Mark, also, introduced Dan Chisholm as the newest member of the Board of Directors.

Our featured guest speaker on ice fishing was unable to make it, so Mark turned the floor over to Member Al Weichert for an impromptu presentation on some of the ice fishing techniques he has used over the years. Al did a great job with a little help from Member Bob Paradise. We really appreciate them being put on the spot. Thanks Al & Bob. As the meeting went on, Jerry Zabel & Doug Karakas held a clinic at the rear of the room on building simple, cheap throwable life saving devices made from gallon jugs, rope & a washer. Material was provided by the club to make 24 of the throwables. Thanks to Jerry and Doug!

After about a 15 minute break, Mark introduced the Boat Trolling Co-Chairmen, Bob Feisel and Bob Ksionzek. Mark also reviewed the upcoming Boat Trolling schedule, highlighting the new ports of Lexington (April 25) and Pentwater (July 11) as well as the new 2-day tournament being held in Ludington (August 8-9). He then went on to explain the new "333" format for the Pentwater, Ludington II and Manistee tournaments. This will be in addition to the Big Fish pool but for an undetermined amount a Skipper may enter his 3 largest fish caught at these 3 ports. For example, a skipper may choose to enter all 3 of his fish at the Pentwater tournament and not be allowed to enter any more from the Ludington II and Manistee tournaments or one from each of the three aforementioned events or wait till Manistee and select his 3 largest there. Any combination from any of those 3 tournaments but only the 3 largest will be totaled to decide the winner. This will take some strategizing and should add some more fun and excitement to the upcoming schedule.

Mark then turned the floor over to Bob Mitchell who attended the January Lake Michigan workshop held by Michigan SeaGrant in Ludington. Bob gave an excellent and thorough report on the topics that were discussed there and fielded questions from the membership. The tackle raffles featured some nice Ice Fishing rods & reels, fleece jackets & hats as well as bags of tackle. The 75/25 raffle 1st prize of \$90 cash was won by Jody Robinson and unfortunately, we didn't get the name of the person who won the 2nd Prize, a \$50 Gander Mountain Gift Card.
