Weigh-in Time

Charcoal Broiled Salmon

- Salmon steaks -1-inch thick
- ¼ lb. butter
- 1 teaspoon onion powder
- ½ teaspoon pepper
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- ½ teaspoon paprika
- 1 ½ teaspoons of Worcestershire sauce

Melt butter and add the rest of the ingredients. Put steaks on a hot grill. Generously spread sauce over fish with basting brush. Cook until crispy brown on both sides and meat is white. Do not overcook.

WALNUT-CRUSTED TROUT FILLETS

From Greunke's First Street Inn. The restaurant's menu focuses on fish sourced from Lake Superior.

- 4 servings:
- 1/2 cup all purpose flour
- 3 tablespoons dried rubbed sage
- 1 tablespoon salt
- 1 1/2 teaspoons ground black pepper
- 2 large eggs
- 2 cups finely chopped walnuts
(about 10 ounces)
- 2 9-to 10-ounce trout, boned, heads removed, butterflied, halved (4 fillets)
- 2 tablespoons (1/2 stick) butter
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 lemon, quartered lengthwise

Chopped fresh parsley

Using fork, stir flour, sage, salt, and pepper on large plate to blend. Whisk eggs in medium bowl to blend.

Place walnuts on large plate. Sprinkle trout fillets with salt and pepper. Dredge trout in flour mixture, then dip in eggs to coat. Press both sides of trout in walnuts to coat.

Melt 1 tablespoon butter with 1 tablespoon oil in each of 2 heavy large skillets over medium heat.

Add 2 trout fillets to each skillet. Cook until coating is lightly browned and trout are cooked through, about 5 minutes per side.

Transfer trout to plates. Squeeze 1 lemon wedge over each fillet, sprinkle with parsley and serve.

Salmon Spread

- 8 oz. cooked or smoked salmon (great way to use leftovers)
- 1 package 8 oz cream cheese, softened
- 3 tablespoons sliced green onions
- Three drops of Tabasco sauce

Mix all together, refrigerate and serve with crackers.
