THIRD ANNUAL SPORTSMEN'S DINNER

The Detroit Area Steelheaders will be hosting our third Sportsmen's Dinner on Saturday, March 9, 2002. The response from this past year's attendees was very positive especially regarding the great food. This year we will return to the Salt River Golf Club Banquet Center. It is conveniently located at 33633 23 Mile Road, New Baltimore, 2.4 miles east of I94 (Exit #243). The hall is finely decorated with large windows providing a wonderful view of the golf course. To improve from last year, the hall has fixed the sound system and we have removed 3 dining tables to make more room for diners. Another bartender will also be working. This will be a traditional sportsmen's dinner with a game

menu, an impressive display of taxidermy, and raffles.

The dinner will be cooked by the same highly praised caterer as last year. The food will include at least five wild game entrees such as pheasant, caribou, buffalo, etc, and pop and beer.

This year's raffles will have Great Lakes fishing gear, and yet still have some of the popular guns. We expect to have upwards of 90 raffle prizes. This will be one of our major fundraisers for 2002, perhaps our biggest and best.
