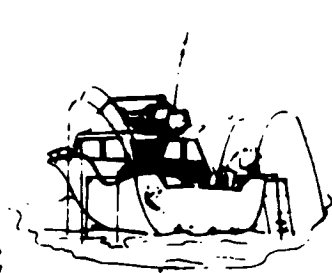

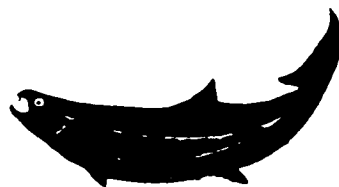
The tickets are a real bargain when you consider they include food, open bar, dancing and a chance at the door prize. Be sure to see Doug Karakas for tickets.
